What are your backgrounds (eg. education background, nationality, age, location, and career stage (eg. years of experience)

I have an academic background in law and international legal studies, with a strong focus on European and international law, human rights, and legal practice. I completed my LL.B. at Universidad Carlos III de Madrid and am currently pursuing an LL.M. in European and International Law at Universität Hamburg. Additionally, I am participating in a Human Rights Exchange Program at CEU University in Vienna, Austria, and working towards a Master's in Law Practice and Procuratorship at Universidad Internacional de la Rioja (UNIR) (2025) to qualify for bar admission in Spain.

At this stage in my career, I am transitioning from legal studies to a professional role in international organizations, building on my experience in research, legal analysis, and volunteer work. My goal is to apply my legal expertise in international institutions and NGOs, focusing on human rights, policy, and advocacy.
