

Career Coaching Programme for IOs/NGOs

A message from the Founder - Wiola Stasieluk

I created IO Ready after years of trial and error, attempts and failures, until I got 'IN' and started understanding how getting a job in international organisations ACTUALLY looks like.

After I worked at the EU, UN, OECD, I realised that the information about the recrutiment and employment at IOs was inaccurate! I was shocked to realise that the world of IOs has its own internal processes, unspoken, political, hidden, that candidates do not know about....



I became determined to bring this knowledge to make sure that everyone has an equal chance of getting their dream job in IOs/NGO!

That's when I decided to build up my career coaching programme for international organisations. In each session, I combine sharing my knowledge and examples from my own experiences from working at the EU, UN and the OECD and give you exercises to reflect/practice the skills that we have discussed in a session.

Programme Structure:

5 sessions in total each a building block for the next

• Your Career Goals

Identify career path, research IOs/NGOs, create a concrete career plan.

Your Skills

Analyse existing skills, identify skills to develop, create a skills development plan.

Your Networking

Improve networking skills, build a network, establish a reputation in IOs/NGOs.

Your Job Application

Craft CV and motivation letter, review from recruiter's perspective, implement lessons and receive feedback.

Your Strategy

Understand job market, develop career strategies, explore job sources, and undergo a recruitment process simulation.

Session Details



- Format: Hybrid (pre-recorded videos + live coaching)
 - **Pre-session**: 2-6 hours of videos and exercises
 - Live session: 1-hour one-on-one coaching
 - Post-session: 1-2 hours of homework
- Intensity: Flexible scheduling (most popular: 1 session per week)
- Engagement: Full dedication required (4-6 hours per session)

Structure: Online Course + 1-1 Coaching Session

Get clarity on your short-term, mid-term and long-term goals!

Through visualisation, worksheet exercises and individual work, we explore your immediate - and far-away work objectives.
